Gloria Dei Preschool COVID -19 POLICY 2022-23

The CDC updated their operational guidance for Early Care Education programs on 8/11/22. Gloria Dei Preschool is relaxing COVID-19 policies to reflect this change.

The CDC recommends staying up to date with COVID-19 vaccinations as it is the leading public health strategy to prevent severe disease.

Staying Home When Sick

- People who have symptoms of respiratory or gastrointestinal infections, such as cough, fever, sore throat, vomiting, or diarrhea, should stay home and may return to school when symptom free for 24 hours, without fever reducing medication.
- People who test positive for COVID-19, must stay home for at least 5 days. The start of symptoms is day 0. People are most infectious during these first 5 days.
- People who are exposed to COVID-19 no longer need to quarantine regardless of vaccination status. An exposed person should stay home and get tested if symptoms occur.

Hand Hygiene

- Proper handwashing will be reinforced before and after eating, after using the bathroom and recess.
- Hand sanitizers may be used with adult supervision and stored out of the reach of children.

Cleaning

- Surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- Classrooms, bathrooms and play areas are professionally cleaned every evening.

Masking

 Masks are not required unless there is an outbreak of COVID-19. If this occurs, we will work with the Montgomery County Department of Public Health to receive guidance to reduce transmission, which may include masking, improving ventilation, opening windows and doors, etc.

This policy is subject to change according to local Health Department or CDC recommendations.
