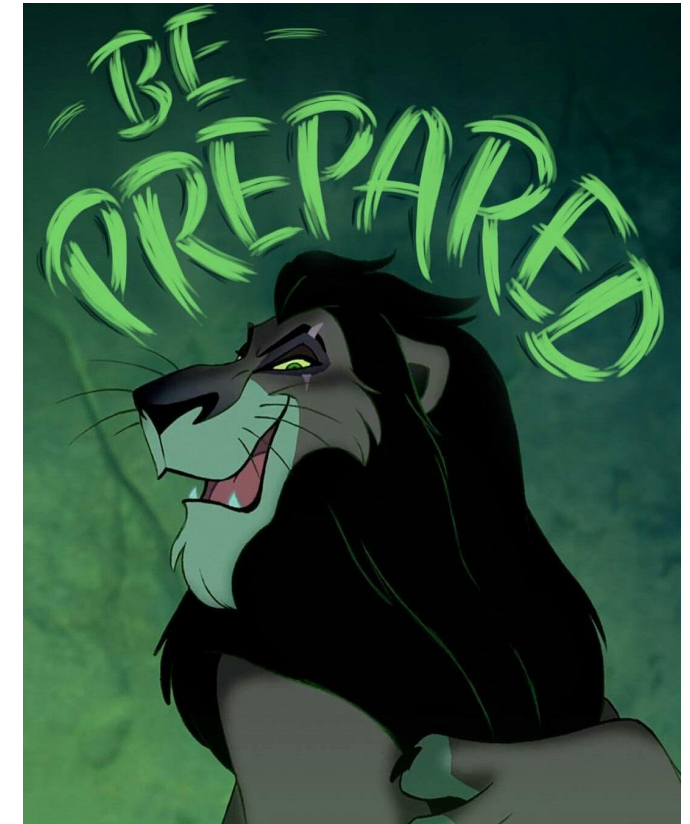
-8:30AM Worship: held every Sunday in the Chapel with piano, hymns, a message, and Communion served weekly.
